	allow us to better tailor to different audiences. Agreed by	
	Board. TD will identify project plan and funding required for	
	this work (Action 73).	
	SK Premise: School Wynd/Hooks: School Wynd owner not	AG
	interested in meeting our requirements for a sale. Hooks is C-	
	listed and AG would like to continue to investigate. Likely this	
	would require several community groups. Land Commission	
	could help fund a feasibility study. If SK led on this, we would	
	need to update our constitution to allow voting members to be	
	restricted to Kirrie locals (a LC requirement). Board agreed	
	for AG to continue investigation (Action 74).
